and they usually made people stare.)

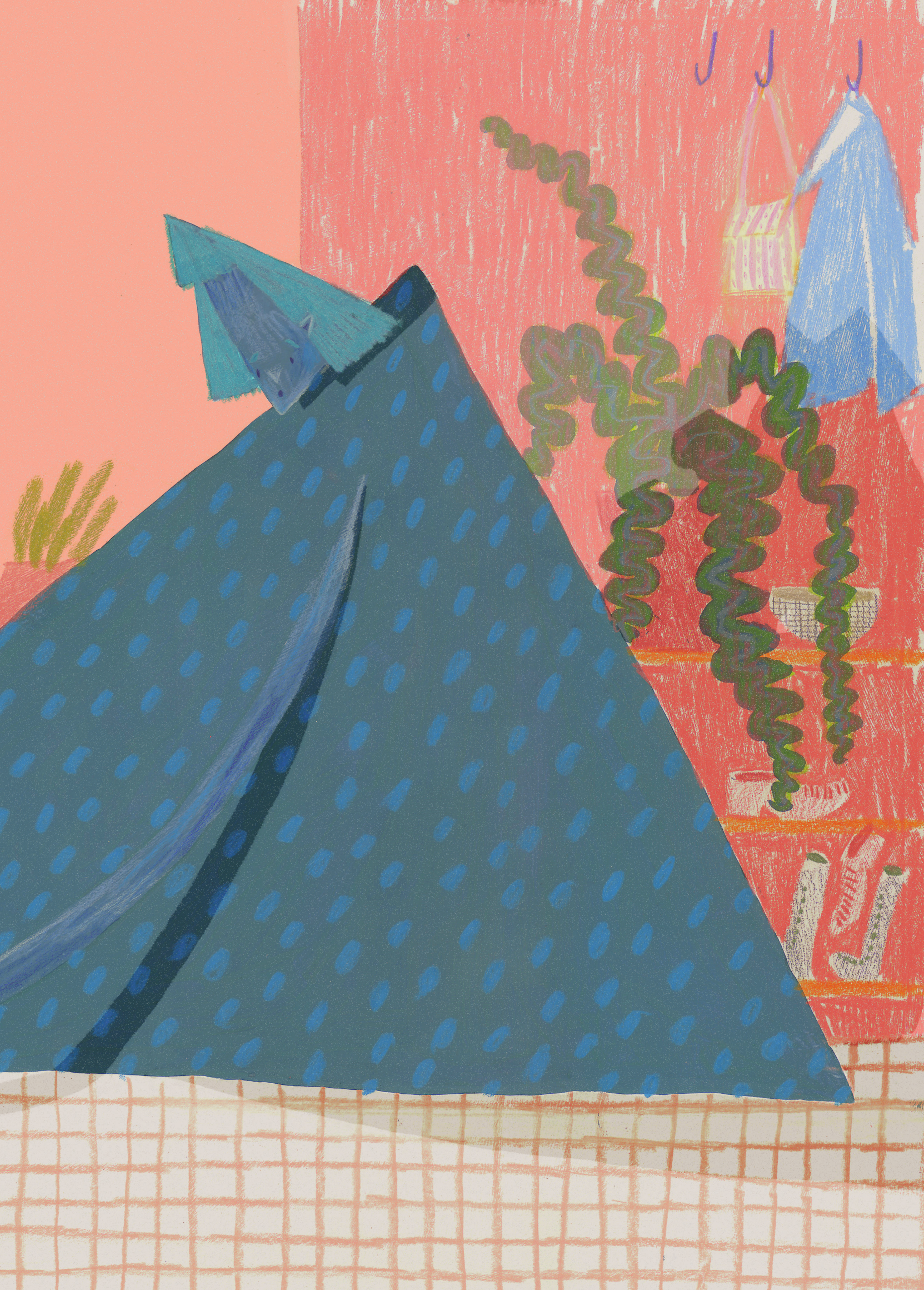




"Do I have to go? I wish I was a circle looking amazing.
